


FIELD TRIP

CHAPERONE INFO



Thanks for volunteering to chaperone a Muddy Sneakers field trip! Together, we can encourage a safe and productive learning environment for all. Here's what to expect:

What do chaperones do?

- Accompany a group of students, led by a Muddy Sneakers Field Instructor
- Serve as a "sweep," ensuring the group stays together
- Responsible for behavior management and discipline if students are disruptive, fail to follow directions, or misbehave
- Model safe, appropriate behavior for students, including:
 - No smoking, vaping, or using other tobacco products
 - Minimize cell phone usage
 - Practice *Leave No Trace* principles
- Administer first aid per school policy
- Are prepared to cooperate & assist at any time; for example, if an emergency arises
- Defer to Instructors for all aspects of the field trip, especially safety
- If your child is a group member, please allow them to participate fully in the experience

What to bring/wear

- ✓ Lunch/snacks
- ✓ 2 full bottles of water
- ✓ Closed-toe shoes
- ✓ Weather-appropriate attire/layers
- ✓ Sunscreen/bug spray (optional)

What NOT to bring/wear

- ✗ Dogs, infants, other children
- ✗ Flip-flops/open-toed shoes

PLEASE NOTE: You may walk 1 to 3 miles, on rough terrain, with no bathroom facilities (other than the great outdoors)!
