

Outdoor Safety First


At Muddy Sneakers Outdoor Classroom, student safety and comfort are a priority in all weather conditions. Weather concerns are discussed in advance when possible. Cancellation or rescheduling decisions are typically made by 5 pm the day before the program. If unexpected weather arises, the Program Manager will contact the group lead as soon as possible to discuss options.

Possible Cancellation Criteria:

Programs may be canceled or shortened due to unsafe weather, including lightning, extreme cold, high winds, or poor air quality.

-  More than a 60% chance of heavy rain or thunderstorms
-  Wind chill at or below freezing
-  Temperatures below freezing without consistent sunshine
-  Sustained winds 15+ mph or gusts of 30+ mph
-  Air Quality Index (AQI) of 151 or higher

Weather Cancellation & Safety Guidelines



Program Day Weather Safety:

Lightning: Any sighting requires immediate shelter.
Thunder: At the first thunder, groups move to the parking area.
A second thunder results in immediate program cancellation.

Participation requires weather-appropriate attire.

Weather Closures and Delays:

Muddy Sneakers does not operate when your group has weather-related delays or closures. We will reschedule your program.

Activity Adjustments for Cold Days

To help students stay warm, instructors will prioritize hiking and active games earlier in the day and adjust activities as needed based on conditions.
